



EXHIBITION RULES LAUSANNE 2008

1. The exhibitor that has subscribed must pay his booth in advance to the postal account 10-22447-1. Payments made at the show will have added an administration fee of CHF 35.00
2. The annulation of a reserved place has to be done the soonest possible by registered letter. The paid amount will be returned only if the place can be re-rented. A 10% fee will be deducted for administration costs.
3. Each exhibitor engages himself to contribute to the prestige of the mineral show of Lausanne, reserving a maximum of space for beautiful specimens and taking care of a nice presentation.
4. **The setup of your booth is possible Saturday morning from 7h00.** When the exhibition opens at 10h00 the display must be ready and you engage to stay till closing time, without starting to pack early.
5. All mineral specimens must have a tag with the correct scientific mineral name, origin and **price in Swiss Francs.**
6. Showpieces, if not for sale, must be indicated clearly. Written disclosure of repaired or enhanced mineral specimens is indispensable.
7. The booth number must be visible during the whole exhibition. Its purpose is to locate any exhibitor quickly.
8. The table depth is 80 cm. **Under no circumstances the table surface must be enlarged, neither to the front or the back.**
9. **Are not allowed at the exhibition are :**
 - Falsified minerals, synthetics, dyed, assembled imitations of fossils and any article or object which has no link to the mineral world, rocks or fossils.
 - Light sources, which falsify the appearance of minerals (Long wave UV lamps are permitted, short wave UV lamps only with the necessary precautions.)
 - Corals, pearls, shells, ivory and non fossilized animals (respecting nature).
10. **Are tolerated on 30% of the table surface :**
 - Precious stones, semi precious stones, cut and, or set in jewelry. The exhibitor shall announce the quantity in % and apply it.
11. The organizing committee has full authority to control the correct application of the exhibition rules. Also it can request that you clear away all objects that do not fit in this exhibition.
12. The organizing committee has the right to refuse your inscription for a future exhibition, if an exhibitor does not comply with the exhibition rules.
13. The mineralogical society of Vaud (SVM) requests the observation of all prescriptions of the Swiss mineralogical society (ASCMF) concerning the exhibition and sale of radioactive or toxic minerals.
14. The SVM declines all responsibility in case of theft, loss, accident, breakage and other damage or customs problems.
15. The exhibition hall is guarded only during the night from Saturday to Sunday.
16. **These exhibition rules replace the old ones.** In case of doubt, the French version of these exhibition rules is to be referred to.
